Description	
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>	
The two modules of the School of Democracy were held at the Faculty of Social Sciences in Ljubljana on December 10th, 2024, and January 27th, 2025. A third module is planned for March 2025.	
A total of 50 participants took part to the events, including 24 women and 26 men, mostly students aged 18-26. A	

total of 6 lecturers took part to the 2 modules, including professors, academics, representatives of anti-fascist associations, and time-witnesses.

The first module was titled “The Fire that Swept Across Europe: The Rise of Fascist Ideology in Slovenia”, and included lectures from Jelena Juvan, Ljubica Jelušič and Borut Klabjan. They focused on the impact of WWII in Slovenia with emphasis on nationalism of the main cause for rising of Fascist ideology. A total of 25 people took part to the event.

The second module was titled “There, Where Death Fought Until the End”, and included lectures by Ljubica Jelušič, Maca Jogan, and Marijan Križman. The module was held on January 27th, on the occasion of the Holocaust Remembrance Day. It focused on the horrors of imprisonment in concentration camps and personal experience of time-witnesses. A total of 25 people took part to the event.
