Description	
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>	
<p>The WP aimed to answer to the following objectives: increase knowledge of young people on the project's topics, and create opportunities for them to access information in regards of the importance of safeguarding democracy and fundamental rights of EU citizens. The WP also aimed to raise awareness of common European history among youth. In order to do that, the partner organizations planned the youth camp, which was held in Tuhelj, Croatia, from the 25th to the 27th of April. The</p>	

camp involved 32 young people and lecturers from the partner countries, and involved them in discussing opposing narratives connected to WWII and post-war period.

The main topics of discussion included:

- Countering distortion, denial and trivialisation of the historical facts regarding crimes committed on territory of Croatia, Italy and Slovenia and their influence on today European democracy. This topic was addressed through the lectures of Hrvoje Klasić, and Federico Tenca Montini, as well as through the visit to Kumrovec, birth place of Josip Broz Tito and ethno-village.
- Providing justice for victims and preserving the memory of their sacrifice. This topic was addressed through the lectures of Borut Klabjan and the visit to the Gallery of sculptor Antun Augustinčić
- Importance of safeguarding democracy and fundamental rights in EU. This topic was addressed through the lectures of Ljubica Jelušič and Miljenko Hajdarović, as well as the screening of the documentary film „Woods that sing”

During the camp, the young people involved had the chance to exchange views and perspectives with each other, critically approach the mentioned topics, and evaluate the experience through video interviewing each other. They also sent messages to younger generations with their invitations to keep memory alive, approach critically national narratives, and be open to listen to different sides.
